Composition: Ketotifen 1mg Tablet & 1mg/5ml Syrup.

Indications: 1. Bronchial asthma as a prophylactic treatment. 2. Symptomatic treatment of allergic conditions including rhinitis and conjunctivitis.

Dosage & administration: Fenat Tablet: Adults- 1mg twice daily with food. If necessary the dose may be increased to 2mg twice daily. Children from 2 years-0.5mg to 1mg twice daily with food. Elderly- Same as adults or as advised by the registered physician.

Fenat Syrup: 1-2 teaspoonfuls twice daily with food. Patients known to be easily sedated ¹/₂-1 teaspoonful at night for the first few days or as directed by the registered physician.

Children under 2 years of age: 1/2 teaspoonfuls twice daily or as directed by the registered physician.

Contraindications: A reversible fall in the thrombocyte count in patients taking Fenat concomitantly with oral antidiabetic agents has been observed in a few cases. Although there is no evidence of any teratogenic effect, recommendations for Fenat in pregnancy or when breast feeding can not be given.

Precautions: Post-marketing surveillance has shown exacerbation of asthma. Patient should be advised to avoid alcoholic drinks.

Side effects: Dryness of mouth, slight dizziness and drowsiness may occur at the beginning of treatment.
