Composition: Zinc Oxide 40%

Indications: It is indicated for preventing and treating diaper rash as well as minor skin irritations (e.g. cuts, burns, and scrapes, poison ivy). It works by providing a skin barrier to prevent and help to heal skin irritation.

Dosage and Administration: At first, wet and soiled diaper should be changed. Promptly; the diaper area is cleaned & allowed drying. A thin layer of ointment should be applied topically every 8 hourly. It should be applied liberally as often as necessary, with each diaper change, especially at bedtime or any time when exposure to wet diapers may be prolonged. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Side effects: No significant side effects have been reported. Minor skin sensitivity or irritation has been reported in some individuals.

Contraindication: It is contraindicated in patients known to have hypersensitivity to the drug or any of its components.

Use in Pregnancy and Lactation: This medication should be used with precautions only if clearly needed during pregnancy or while breast feeding.

Drug interaction : No significant drug interactions have been reported with topical zinc oxide.
