Composition: Mebeverine HCI 135mg Tablet & 200mg SR Capsule.

Indications: Meverine is indicated for the symptomatic treatment of irritable bowel syndromme and other conditions usually included in this grouping such as: chronic irritable colon, spastic constipation, mucous colitis, spastic colitis. Meverine is also effective in colicky abdominal pain and cramps, persistent, non-specific diarrhoea (with or without alternating constipation) and flatulence.

For the symptomatic treatment of gastrointestinal spasm secondary to organic diseases.

Meverine-SR: Mebeverine Hydrochloride is indicated: For the symptomatic treatment of irritable bowel syndrome (IBS), other conditions include: Chronic irritable colon, Spastic constipation, Mucous Colitis, Colicky abdominal pain, Persistent non-specific diarrhoea.

Dosages: Adults & Children over 10 years, 1 tablet 3 times daily, preferably 20 minutes before meals or as directed by a registered physician.

Meverine-SR: Adults, elderly: 1 Capsule twice daily, preferably 20 minutes before meals. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Precautions: Caution should be exercised in porphyria or allergic reaction to this or any other medicine of this group.

Use in pregnancy and lactation : No teratogenicity has been shown in animal experiments. However, the usual precautions concerning the administration

of any drug during pregnancy should be exercised. Mebeverine dose not excrete in the breast milk after administering at therapeutic dose.

Drug interaction: Not known.

Contraindication: Hypersensitivity to the drug or any other ingredients.

Side effects: Not known.
