Composition: Each Sustained Release Capsule Contains Isosorbide-5-Mononitrate 50mg.

Indications: Monocard-SR is indicated for use in the treatment & prophylaxis of angina pectoris.

Dosage & Administration: The usual oral dose is 1 capsule (50mg) daily or as directed by the registered physician.

Contraindications: Monocard-SR is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to isosorbide mononitrate or isosorbide dinitrate.

Adverse effects: Headache, feelings of dizziness, hypotension may occur sometimes.

Precautions: No dosage adjustment is necessary in the elderly or in those with renal or hepatic impairment.

Use in Pregnancy and lactation:

Safety on pregnant women has not been established, excretion in human milk is unknown.

Packing: Monocard-SR: Each box contains 6 x 7's capsules in blister pack.
