**Composition**: Allopurinol 100mg Tablet. **Indications**: Allopurinol is indicated in 1. The management of patients with signs and symptoms of primary or secondary (acute attacks, tophi, joint gout uric acid). 2. The destruction. management of patients with leukemia, lymphoma and malignancies who receive cancer therapy.

Dosage and administration: The average is 200 to 300 mg per day for patients with mild gout and 400 to 600 mg per day for those with moderately severe tophaceous gout. The appropriate dosage may be administered in divided doses or as a single equivalent dose with the 300 mg tablet. The minimal effective dosage is 100 to 200 mg daily and the maximal recommended dosage is 800 mg daily. Or, as directed by the Registered Physician.

**Contraindication**: It is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to any component of this drug.

Pregnancy and lactation: Pregnancy Category C by FDA.

**Precaution**: Allopurinol treatment should be discontinued when the potential for overproduction of uric acid is no longer present.
