Composition: Cetrin Soft Capsule: Each soft gelatin capsule contains Cetirizine Dihydrochloride BP 10mg.

Pharmacology Cetirizine Dihydrochloride is a potent H1 receptor without significant antagonist any anticholinergic and antiserotonin effects. At pharmacologically active dose levels, it has almost no drowsiness effect and does not cause behavioral changes. It inhibits the histamine-mediated early phase of the allergic reaction and also reduces the migration of inflammatory cells and the release of mediators associated with the late phase of the allergic reaction.

Indication: It is indicated for the relief of symptoms-

It is indicated for the relief of symptoms associated with seasonal allergic rhinitis due to allergen. Symptoms treated effectively include sneezing, rhinorrhea, pruritus, ocular pruritus, tearing and redness of the eyes.

It is indicated for the relief of symptoms associated with perennial allergic rhinitis due to allergens. Symptoms treated effectively include sneezing, rhinorrhea, post-nasal discharge, nasal pruritus, ocular pruritus and tearing.

It is indicated for the treatment of the uncomplicated skin manifestations of chronic idiopathic urticaria. It is also used in allergen induced asthma.

Dosage and administration: Adults and children 6 years and over: one (10 mg) capsule once daily; Daily dose not to exceed more than one (10 mg) capsule in 24 hours. A 5 mg product may be appropriate for less severe symptoms. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Precautions: Caution in patients with when driving a car or operating potentially dangerous machinery. Concurrent use with alcohol, tranquilizers or sedatives or other CNS depressants, liver or kidney disease should be avoided. Somnolence has been reported in some patients.

Side effects: Most common side effects are: Fatigue, dry mouth, pharyngitis, dizziness, headache, diarrhea, nausea etc

Use in pregnancy & lactations: There are no adequate and well controlled studies in pregnant women. Not recommended in nursing mother.

Use in Child: The safety & effectiveness of this medicine in children with less than 6 years of age have not been established.

Drug Interactions: There are no available in data.

Overdose: There are no available in data.

Storage: Store below 30°C in a dry place.

Packing: Cetrin Soft Capsule: Each box contains 4 x 15's capsules in blister pack.
